## WALK FACING TRAFFIC

For your safety, if you must walk on the side of the road, choose the side where you are facing oncoming traffic. This gives you the best chance to see traffic approaching closest to you. It will also allow you precious time to take evasive action when needed.

When you walk while facing traffic, you can see the driver's face and get a better read on what they are doing.

Are drivers

- Looking at the road?
- Looking down?
- Looking at their cell phone?
- Texting?
- Looking at a GPS?
- Reading directions?
- Eating?

## WALK FACING TRAFFIC TO SAVE YOUR LIFE

When you walk facing traffic, drivers can see you. As you get out and walk more and more, you will get a general sense of what drivers are going to do.

- 90% of drivers see me and either slow down or move slightly over the center line to give themselves room to pass me.
- 9% of drivers are clueless or worse...distracted.
- 1% of drivers are just plain dangerous and you must avoid them at all costs.

## WALK SAFETY FACTS

- In 2017, there were nearly 6,000 pedestrian fatalities.
- Speed Kills: a pedestrian hit at 20 miles per hour has a 10% chance of dying.
- Getting hit at 40 miles per hour increases the death rate to 80%

## YOUR "NEXT STEP"

- Vow to never walk with your back to traffic. You can't avoid what you don't see coming at you.
- Plan your walking routes on less traveled roads and neighborhoods.
- **If walking at night, wear a reflective vest and use a flashlight.**


## Waffle Bar


