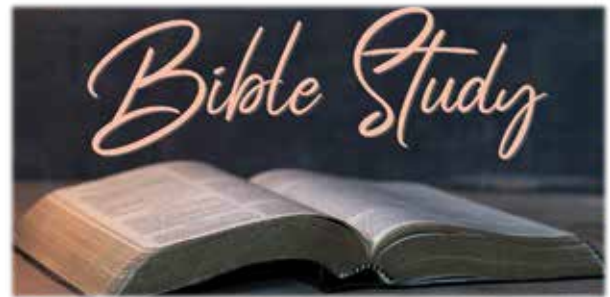


All Things Apple Club

Voyager Computer Resource Center

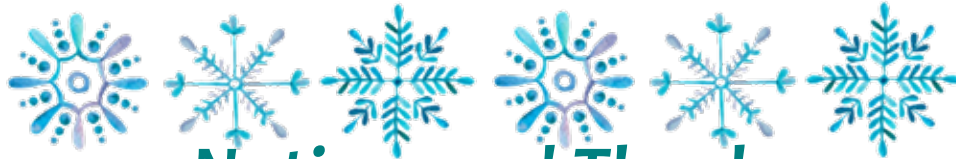
