MONTHLY COURTESY PATROL NEWS

Main Gate Operations

During peak season, delays in entering the park should be expected. Procedures are in place and options are available to the officer to utilize. It is at the officer's discretion how he or she uses them. Honking your horn and screaming obscenities at the officer does nothing more than distract them from getting their tasks done sooner. Thank you for your patience.

Golf Cart Operators

To drive a golf cart, you must have a valid driver's license. For safety and security, all golf carts must be registered in the Registration Office. While out in the Resort, golf carts may only park in designated golf cart parking areas. Specific handicap parking spaces are provided at many Resort facilities for golf carts. **Don't forget to use hand signals!!!**

Children are not allowed to operate a golf cart at any time. Children are never allowed to sit in an operator's lap while a passenger.

Exiting Driveways and Carports

Please use extreme caution when exiting your driveways and carports. Numerous reports of near misses have been reported to the Courtesy Patrol. I have had three myself in the last two weeks.

Exit and Entry Road for Main Gate

Speeding and passing other vehicles are not permitted on these roads or any other roads on site.

Traffic and Stop Signs

The speed limit is 15 MPH throughout Voyager. The speed limit will be enforced by Voyager for your safety. All vehicles (cars, bicycles, golf carts, etc.) must obey all traffic signs and speed limits.

Everyone needs to stop at all Stop Signs. If the Stop sign is recessed back from the intersection, stop at the sign, and slowly move forward to ensure the intersection is clear before proceeding.

If the stop sign is at an unobstructed view intersection you still must stop, look in all directions and proceed when safe to do so.

Bay Gate

Please have your guests and contractors use the Bay Gate for entry. There are posted instructions to get remote access.



Suggestions to SUMMERIZE YOUR HOME



TURN OFF WATER

- 1. Drain pipes if possible
- 2. Shut off ALL faucets
- 3. DO NOT close or plug drains!
- 4. Pour a cup of RV antifreeze down every drain
- 5. Shut off water behind washing machine
- 6. Shut off water behind refrigerator
- 7. Shut off water to toilet and sinks
- 8. Verify/Install a shut off valve to every water source in the home

HIRE A CARETAKER

- 1. Check the home once a month
- 2. With flashlight look under sinks, around toilets and hot water tank for signs of water
- 3. Check the home within 24 hrs after storms
