On behalf of all of us at Voyager, welcome back! Last year around this time, I had mentioned several of the green initiatives we were working on to ensure Voyager is a leader in sustainability and responsible business practices. These efforts go hand-in-hand with those of our hard-working residents, who continue to exceed expectations in donations and other services outside our community.

As the months progress, you will be pleased to see the impact of these efforts in future editions of our newsletter as we con-

tinue our efforts in programs such as the Salvation Army Toy Drive.

We are continuing to upgrade heating and cooling systems with more efficient units, which only makes sense with the recent trend in warmer temperatures. The digital thermostats and other smart technologies have made an impact in energy savings, and we are continuing to replace our lighting with LEDs with every opportunity. Be on the lookout for these green initiatives and more when you tour the resort.

We're all looking forward to being able to tour the new exercise and lap pool decks. Our upgrade project includes replacing the Cool Pool Deck coating with designer "Desertlock" sand-set pavers. Desertlock pavers blend rich desert aggregates and seashells gathered from nature to create an elegant look throughout the landscape. These pavers are designed to remain cool in the desert sun and are smooth and comfortable for the feet while meeting high standards for slip resistance. The pools themselves are being enhanced with a custom pebble tec product that features blue glass and abalone shell for a unique and beautiful water color. We are not immune to the supply chain challenges many are experiencing in recent months, and this has unfortunately caused a minor delay for this project. Our new target date for completion is end of October. We appreciate your patience and understanding as we work closely with our contractor to maintain the project timeline as closely as possible.

We have also redesigned the breezeway with a durable and sustainable Alumawood awning. These shade structures require little to no maintenance and look great for years to come and blend in with our resort style elements. We have made several other improvements in addition to our usual ongoing projects. For example, we have replaced the Inn locks with a new RFID technology that will allow our guests even more flexibility as well as enhanced reliability.

Speaking of ongoing projects, we sent letters out to remind residents that we will be completing paving operations this month. As I am sure you are aware, supply chain issues this year pushed some of our projects later than usual. But not to worry, we will continue to protect our investments with projects such as paving, and adding isolation valves where needed as we continue to make improvements in our infrastructure.

We also sent out an update notifying our community of our all-inclusive pet policy, which will make Voyager 100% pet friendly come January 1st, 2023. There will be other reminders to come, but please remember to familiarize yourself with our pet policy rules, which are currently in effect and will continue to be post January 1st. We have placed dog waste stations conveniently throughout the community. Please clean up after your pet. While we are a pet friendly resort, please consider those around you and keep our four-legged friends on a proper leash. A complete list of pet policy rules and regulations is available at our front desk. Also, please take a moment to read up on pet rules and more in our recently revised Rules and Regulations. We want everyone to enjoy their time with us, so don't forget to brush up on traffic safety rules and other important safety reminders.

This year has been especially warm, and we want everyone to take precautions to stay hydrated and avoid heat related illnesses. We recommend you carry a water bottle and fill it up frequently at our bottle filling stations, which are replacing our drinking fountains in several areas of the resort. We have been working hard to ensure our amenities reflect the changing needs of our residents. If you have questions about any of the above initiatives or enhancements, please let any of us know. We have a suggestion box in the lobby if you are in a hurry and want to drop us a line. While we are sure you will immediately notice our recent improvements; don't just take my word for it! You will be greeted on Kolb Road by our fantastic new water tower mural that points you towards our award-winning resort.

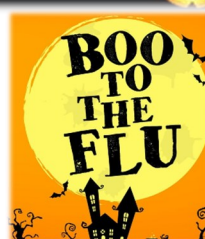

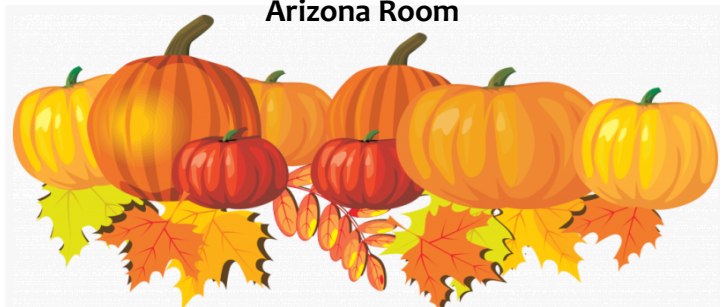
Market Daze and Craft Fair

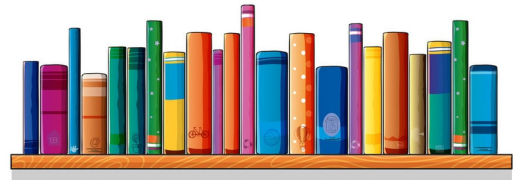

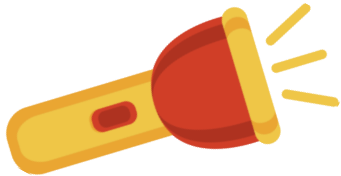
